BEHIND THE VISION

Jesus entrusts us the responsibility to go to all men, from all nations and languages, from all cultures and subcultures, from all layers of the socio-economic landscape, and make disciples, to baptize them, and to teach them (Matthew 28:19, 20). The gospel of John has at its very core making Jesus known as the son of God, and God himself. Through the pages of his gospel, John does not shy away from each one of Jesus' statements of identity, where the son of God emphatically and unapologetically makes known who He is.
